Gooseberry Planet is an award-winning software platform, which is designed to educate children, teachers <u>and</u> **parents** about the dangers online through **game-based learning**. In other words, we offer a fully interactive and engaging game platform from which children can learn to use the internet responsibly and safely. The software is intended to be used both in schools and at home: it offers a child-centered and coordinated approach to safeguarding and is **totally unique** as it also offers an assessment and monitoring system for both teachers and parents. We have created a 12-month programme for each and every child in every year of School (5-13 years-old). Gooseberry Play consists of three portals that work alongside each other:





The **Gooseberry Teacher** platform is also full of resources, including workbooks, lesson plans, handouts and much more. The programme is a pickup and go, teachers are too busy to research, the work has been completed already. Each lesson has been designed to educate the teacher before any lesson begins. It will guide a teacher through the lesson as every element of resource and referred.

Gooseberry Teacher works with Gooseberry Student; this allows the teacher to monitor the class whilst playing in lesson or at home. The software will show if a student isn't responding in the correct manner. The key is highlighting who is potentially vulnerable. It also controls exactly what the class is playing to students to not move onto the next lesson.


In the below image is an overview of our 12-month programme. Each lesson is support with workbooks, lesson plans, classroom PowerPoint, workbook answers and parent handout.

Gooseberry Student allows your students to play our engaging game and learn through consequence. As they play their reactions to 'real life' scenarios are recorded. There is also a workbook that compliments the game and creates a conversation with the teachers and classmates. The feedback from Students has been very positive, to the point where in some schools (who have relaxed their mobile phone usage) the game is being played during break times and out of school.



Gooseberry Planet CPD – E-learning Training

This e-learning CPD's contains training need to meet the statutory requirements in KCSIE September 2019.

Staff can access the training in their own time and at their own pace, via accessible modules, each followed by a short assessment, (parts of which are scenario-based), to check understanding. They may re-visit the modules as often as they wish to improve or refresh their knowledge

Results are available to designated safeguarding leads or Head Teacher so that they can check that training has been completed and identify any areas of weakness. On completion, staff obtain a certificate confirming they have passed. There is a refresher quiz to be completed three months after the main training has been completed.

All schools have access to the training for 12 months, teachers can also be added at any point during the year.

Gooseberry Safeguarding CPD is an Online Safeguarding training programme for all schools and colleges. It has been developed for all staff, including support and site staff associated with a school. Our Safeguarding CPD has been developed in response to the statutory requirements for safeguarding of children in education. This new documentation has been updated, commencing September 2018.

- 13 modules broken down into 10-minute modules, including: Roles and Responsibilities, what to do if you have concerns for a child, what to do if you have concerns about safeguarding and Contextual Safeguarding
- 3-month refresher
- Reporting of progress for every member of staff
- **E** Learning support for 12 months.

Gooseberry Prevent CPD is in partnership with a highly respected Prevent practitioner and subject matter expert, Gooseberry Planet have developed a comprehensive, accessible CPD that covers all aspects of the Prevent Duty that affect education. It is also the most upto-date training available, incorporating the recently released **CONTEST Strategy 2018** (which includes significant changes to Prevent) as well as the latest Home Office Channel referral figures which highlight the essential role that education plays in safeguarding young people through Prevent.

The CPD is divided into 7 sections, each one with a short assessment at the end to check understanding. Case studies involving different types of extremism (based on real-life Prevent referrals) are incorporated throughout the module to reinforce the learning and bring the CPD to life.
